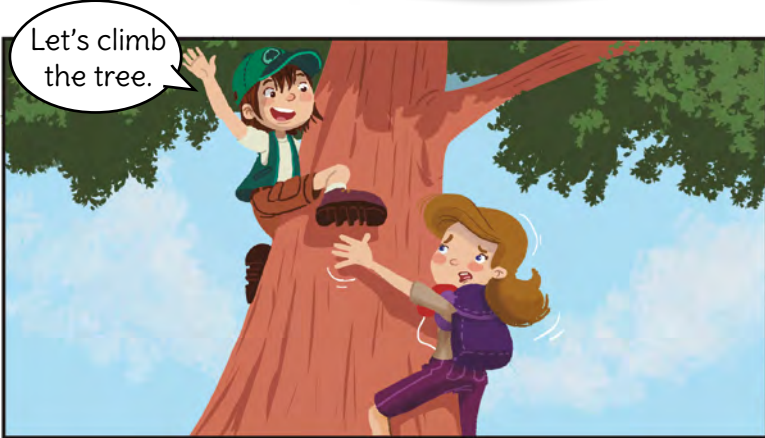


A scary house
