Articles New habits, new screens

In the past, teenagers were TV fans, but now the Internet is more popular. Teenagers' habits are different now because they've got new technologies at hand. Today, young people watch only 1 or 2 hours of TV a day, and they spend between 5 and 8 hours on the Internet. What do they do online? They usually watch videos on YouTube or TikTok, play online games, post photos or chat with friends. And do they do everything on their smartphones? It's true that teens prefer their smartphones to go online, but some of them use their computers or their tablets.

Today teenagers also watch films and series at any time via on demand services. They watch them on TV or on their tablets, smartphones or computers.
