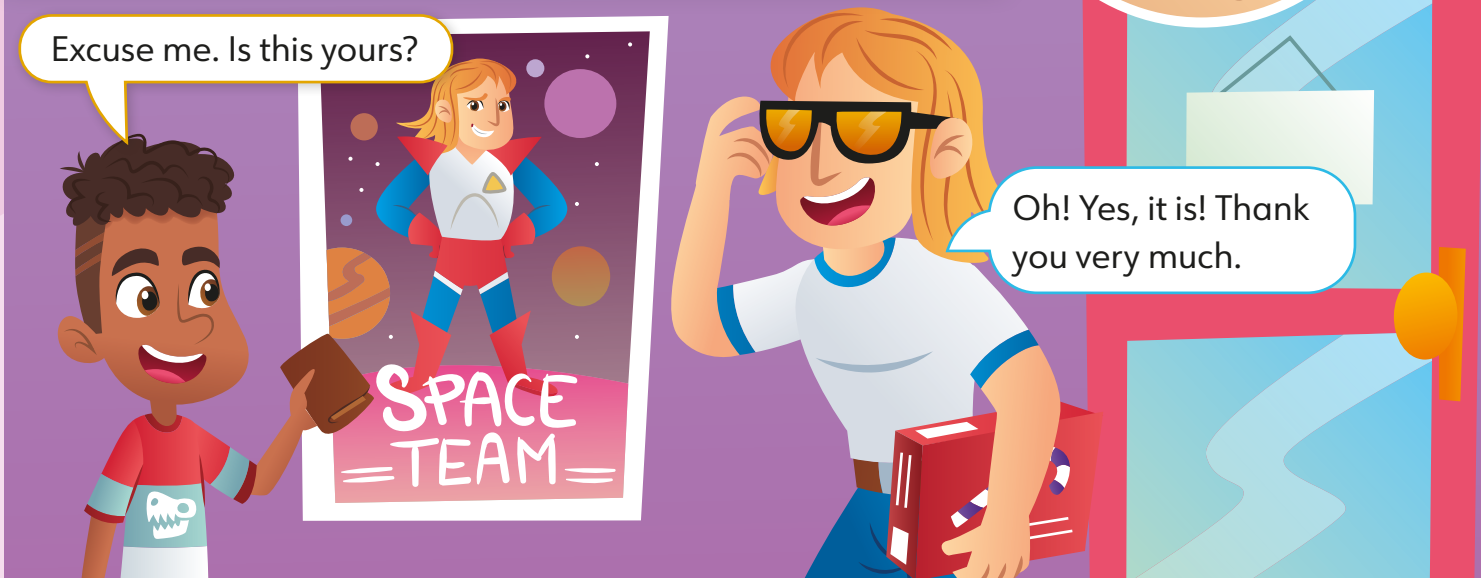

The History of Movies

The word *movie* is short for “moving pictures.”

In 1895, the Lumière brothers showed a short movie of Paris. This was one of the first public movies. It was about a minute long, it was black and white, and it had no **sound**, but people loved it.

For many years, movies were **silent**. People read part of the story or plot from the **screen**.

The technology for sound came in 1927, but most movies were still black and white. Movie **directors** experimented with **special effects**.

The first **cartoon** movies, such as Walt Disney’s *Snow White* in 1937, were very popular. By 1950, most movies were in color.

In 1995, *Toy Story* was one of the first movies to use CGI—computer generated images. Many movies today use CGI.

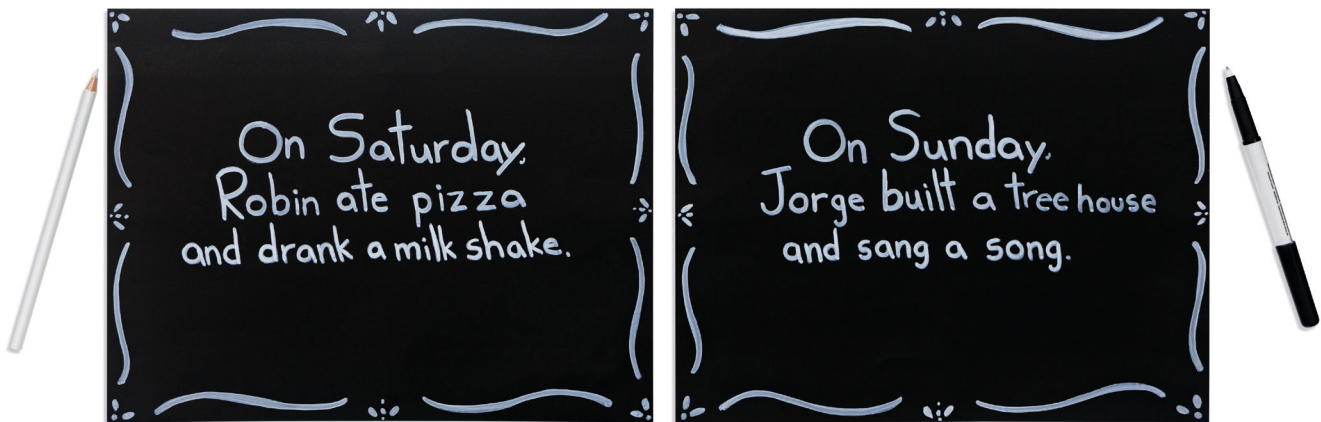

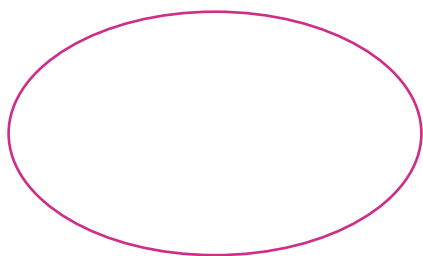

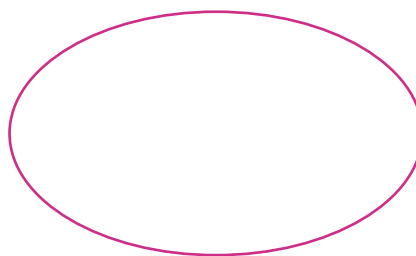

Tree House

Tree House is the new CGI animated movie from Japan.

Film time: 1 hour 40 minutes

Director: Hinata Tanaka

The plot:

The movie tells the story of Sana, a nine-year-old girl who lives with her father in the country. Sana never smiles or laughs. Her father builds her a tree house to make her happy. At first, Sana doesn't climb up into the tree house, but one day, she hears somebody singing a song in it. When she climbs up into the tree house, she discovers a new world full of extraordinary characters, and her adventures are about to begin.

Additional information

Hinata Tanaka decided to make the movie after he read the book *My Tree House* by Emily Wood. He took five years to make it, and he **filmed** it all in Tokyo's film studios. More than twenty-five **CGI** designers and engineers worked with him.



W2W's review:

The CGI special effects are amazing. The movie is full of exciting action scenes to make the audience **shout** out in surprise. There are also some very funny dialogues between the characters, as well as moments that will make you cry.

The music for the movie is very beautiful. Tanaka used a group of traditional Japanese instruments called *wagakki*, which include string, wind, and percussion instruments. This **soundtrack** gives the movie a very interesting atmosphere.
